

Adult Sunday School Options Fall Curriculum 2011

Discovery Class - led by Kathy Lyles

This class will use a power point format to present the lesson along with group discussion and sometimes arts and crafts.

- The Book of Acts, including Paul's journeys
- The class will take a break from Acts for Advent and Lenten studies.

Fellowship Class - led by Jean Moore

These class lessons will primarily be presented in lecture format.

- The Present Word – Uniform Lesson Series
This quarter's topic is "Tradition and Wisdom" – a study of the wisdom literature (Proverbs, Ecclesiastes, Song of Solomon) as well as Jesus' teachings on wisdom from the book of Matthew.

Life and Faith Class - led by Floride and Nick Caldwell

This discussion oriented class, for young adults/college-age students, provides an opportunity to examine how our own life experiences link with our faith.

- "Balance - Living with Life's Demands" from the 20's/30's Bible study series
- Future studies will include: "Prayer - Living in God's Power and Presence" and "Grace - Being Loved, Loving God"

Seekers Class - led by Dr. Bill Wilson

This class involves class participation through discussion, prayer and reading aloud the Bible.

- The Epistle to the Romans -A Word for Today
In this series of twelve lessons, we will not only present the good news as Paul preached the message, but also show the relevance to our modern human condition.

Sojourners Class-led by Billy Waddell

This class uses group discussion to explore the topic or Bible study.

- "The Will of God In An Unwilling World" by J. Ellsworth Kalas
The author explores the concept of the will of God in a shattered and stubborn world.

Stages Class-led by Anne Seel

The class includes reading from the Bible, teaching and discussion among class members.

- The book of Genesis - a continuation of the study of the beginnings of our faith history. Individuals and couples are welcome to come any Sunday to see how the issues facing our ancient forbearers-in-faith are still pertinent today.
