Discovery Class (Room E203)

The Discovery Class is comprised of adults in their middle years seeking to “discover” God’s truth through Bible study. The class uses a variety of learning methods but mostly lecture and interactive discussion.

Fellowship Class (Room E205)

A strong emphasis on Bible study in a lecture format keeps this class focused on their purpose of promoting knowledge of and obedience to the Bible. Each class begins with a time of praising God through song.

Seekers Class (Room E208)

This is a group of couples and singles who share their faith in God as they promote Christian growth through prayer, fellowship, small group discussion, Bible study and outreach to others.

Sojourners Class (Room E201)

This highly energetic class successfully combines the elements of faith, fellowship and community service. Each class begins with Christian fellowship and then focuses on group discussions of Bible scripture, encouraging the sharing of our Christian journey.

Stages Class (Room E101)

This class is made up of people in many different “stages” of their lives and Christian development, with both new and long-time members, all ages, single or married - all are welcome. Their varied life experiences lead to great discussions in their Bible study.

Life and Faith Class (Room E206)

This class is designed with twenty- and thirty-something age adults in mind. All are invited to continue, or begin, your journey of faith and to form deeper relationships with Jesus Christ through study and dialogue with one another. College age students, when home, are welcome here.

Youth Sunday School

Our purpose is to provide a comfortable place for young people 6th through 12th grades to grow in their faith during these formative years. Our goal is to help youth as they explore Scripture and their faith so they can apply it to their lives and become faithful disciples. This is accomplished through basic Bible study and application of faith to life. To complement our Youth Sunday School programs we also offer more intensive Bible studies and fellowship activities throughout the week.

6th Grade (Room E102)

The Sixth Graders will spend the year exploring the Old Testament. We will begin with creation then make our way through the Exodus before learning about the prophets and kings.

7th Grade (Room E104)

The Seventh Graders will spend the year discovering the promises, parables and stories of the New Testament. From the birth of Jesus to the travels of Paul, there is so much to be learned.

8th Grade (Room E102)

The Eighth Graders will begin their confirmation journey. Their time will be spent discussing topics such as discipleship and what it means to be Presbyterian as they prepare to write statements of faith and join the church.

9th-12th Grade (Room E103)

Senior Highs will focus on the Bible and its foundation for their lives through short-term studies. Prayer time and discussion are important components of this class.
